Study Title: *Assessment of antirelapse efficacy and safety of high-dose regimens of liposomal amphotericin B in HIV-negative visceral leishmaniasis (VL) patients.*

Study Arms and Interventions:

The study includes two active treatment arms, both using Liposomal Amphotericin B (AmBisome®), which is a licensed and nationally recommended standard-of-care drug:

Arm 1. Comparator arm 1: Liposomal amphotericin B at 10 mg/kg body weight, administered intravenously as a single dose over 2-4 hours

Arm2. Intervention arm 1: Liposomal amphotericin B at 15 mg/kg body weight, administered intravenously as a single dose over 4-6 hours

Arm 3. Intervention arm 2: Liposomal amphotericin B at 20 mg/kg body weight, administered intravenously as a single dose over 8-10 hours

Drug administration is completed within a day hospitalisation for 3 days

Site and Facilities:

All trial procedures are conducted at ICMR-RMRIMS, Patna, a tertiary-care government research hospital with extensive experience in VL management.

An established referral arrangement exists with Nalanda Medical College & Hospital (NMCH), Patna, for management of intercurrent illnesses

Risk and Safety Management:

Participants are hospitalized during drug administration and monitored closely for infusion-related reactions, renal toxicity, electrolyte imbalance, and other known risks of amphotericin formulations.

All adverse events, serious adverse events, and compensation determinations are managed and reported as per regulatory requirements.

The study protocol permits dose modification, temporary interruption, or discontinuation of

the study drug strictly for participant safety, based on predefined clinical and laboratory criteria or at the Investigator's medical judgment. Any dose changes are considered risk-mitigation measures and do not constitute protocol deviations when implemented for safety reasons. All adverse events and serious adverse events (SAEs) will be assessed for severity, causality, and outcome, and managed promptly as per standard clinical practice. In the event of an SAE or any medical complication requiring advanced diagnostics, specialist care, or intensive management beyond the facilities available at RMRIMS, the participant will be immediately referred to Nalanda Medical College & Hospital (NMCH) under an existing Memorandum of Understanding. NMCH will provide emergency care, inpatient management, specialist consultations, and supportive treatment as required, with continuity of clinical oversight maintained by the study investigator. However in case if any condition specified in सामान्य नियम और शर्तें/General Terms and Conditions is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement, then it will over ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.

जेम की सामान्य शर्तों के खंड 26 के संदर्भ में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश के बिडर से खरीद पर प्रतिबंध के संबंध में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश का कोई भी बिडर इस निविदा में बिड देने के लिए तभी पात्र होगा जब वह बिड देने वाला सक्षम प्राधिकारी के पास पंजीकृत हो। बिड में भाग लेते समय बिडर को इसका अनुपालन करना होगा और कोई भी गलत घोषणा किए जाने व इसका अनुपालन न करने पर अनुबंध को तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्रवाई का आधार होगा।/In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
